UT SPORTS MEDICINE CAMP

The Longhorn Sports Medicine Camp is designed for high school students who are interested in attaining basic Athletic Training knowledge and skills. The camp consists of lecture and laboratory sessions covering a variety of Athletic Training topics. For the student with previous camp or clinical experience, selected advanced lectures and labs are conducted. Participants also have the opportunity to meet with staff members who are instrumental in the selection of future UT student athletic trainers.

- Anatomy pertinent to athletic injuries
- Injury evaluation techniques
- Principles of injury prevention
- Principles of injury rehabilitation
- Emergency procedures
- Taping and wrapping techniques
