Class Location: Classes will be held in AHG #4, as well as various city of Austin golf courses and driving ranges. You will be responsible for your own transportation. Course Content:

Students must pass a basic golf skills test in order to continue enrollment in the class. (1st day on range)
Learn mechanics and techniques of the full golf swing, pitching, chipping, bunker play and putting. Learn to play better by playing rounds of golf. Learn the basic rules of golf and proper golf etiquette.

Course Requirements:

1. Attend class regularly, dressed appropriate for golf, and participate fully.
2. You must supply your own golf equipment, bag, balls, and tees.
3. You are responsible for your transportation to the class locations.
