Include in your statement any factors (e.g., disability, educational opportunity, economic factors, etc.) you believe may have influenced your GPA and/or GRE scores.

This statement will be an important consideration when your file is reviewed.

Resume or Curriculum Vita

A resume/vita is required of all graduate and non-degree seeking applicants. Please include ALL teaching experience and certifications and/or endorsements.

TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)
